BITS ETC Charity Horse Show Rules and Class Descriptions

- All horses must have proof of current, negative Coggins and Rabies vaccination within the last 12 months.
- ASTM approved safety helmets must be worn by ALL riders while mounted. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Dogs must be on a leash at ALL TIMES.
- Please respect the property and clean up after your horses and trailer area. Thank you.
- Any un-sportsman like conduct or mistreatment of horse may result in being excused from a class or asked to leave the show.
- Geldings and mares only, NO stallions.
- All horses and ponies must be healthy and serviceably sound. Obvious lameness may be cause for disqualification.

Proper Show attire is recommended but *not* required.

English Recommended Attire:

Hunt coat and show shirt

Beige colored breeches

Tall black boot or Paddock boots with half chaps

Riding gloves

Western Recommended Attire:

Western style show shirt

Jeans

Full chaps

Western riding boots

Riding Gloves

Horses should be ridden at a walk in all places except the show and warm up arenas

All jump courses or class patterns will be posted by the in-gate of the show ring(s) at the start of the show

All jump courses will consist of up to 7 jumps of verticals and one oxer (2'-2'3" only). A vertical jump is a single width jump consisting of rails, gates, boxes and/or flower boxes. An oxer jump is 2 vertical jumps together to make the obstacle wider

Horses will be penalized for refusal, run out or other loss of forward motion. Each refusal/run out will result in 4 faults. Horses altering the height or width (knock down of a rail) will result in 4 faults per jump. Knocking or touching the rail is no faults as long as the jump has not been altered.

Grounds for elimination from jumping classes will result from a rider going "off course" (deviating from the posted course for that class), 3 refusals of any jump, or fall of the rider and/or horse.

General Class Rules

Un Judged Warm Up (over fences) (18" and 2'-2'3")

- Course will be posted at the in gate with 7 jumps, including an oxer (2'-2'3" only). This is *not* judged and is an opportunity to school over a course of fences prior to the start of regular show classes.

Hunter Over Fences (18" and 2'-2'3")

Class 1 & 3

To be judged on the horse, way of going, and jumping style. A steady, even pace is desirable over the course of 7 jumps (See USEF Rules)

Equitation Over Fences (18" and 2'-2'3")

Class 2 & 4

To be judged on the rider, rider's position and guiding the horse correctly through the course of 7 jumps (See USEF Rules)

Hunter Hack (18" and 2'-2'3")

Class 5 & 6

This class starts as a flat class with WTC in both directions. At the Judge's request, riders will line up in the center of the ring and each rider will jump 2 jumps and return back to the line up in the center with the other horses

Lead Line (Open to riders 10 years old and under)

Class 7

This class is open to both English and Western riders. A handler must accompany each rider with the horse on a lead line. Judged at a walk in both directions and at the Judge's discretion, may be asked to trot/jog for a short distance.

English Equitation (WTC and WT) Class 8 & 12

Western Equitation (WJL and WJ) Class 10 & 14

All Equitation (under saddle) classes will be judged on the rider's position, form and ability. Riders will be going in both directions on the rail. All under saddle classes to start with riders entering the ring to the right (counter clockwise). (See USEF Rules)

English Pleasure (WTC and WT) Class 9 & 13

Western Pleasure (WJL and WJ) Class 11 & 15 All Please classes will be judged on the suitability of the horse as a pleasure mount, manners and obedience. Horses to be shown with light or little contact. Riders will be going in both directions on the rail. All under saddle classes to start with riders entering the ring to the right (counter clockwise). (See USEF Rules)

***** Classes 16, 17, 18 & 19 will have patterns posted at the start of the show**

Trail Class (class 16)

To be shown (WJL) through a pattern of obstacles consisting of standard trail class type items (including, but not limited to forward and/or reverse through rails on the ground in a "L" pattern, open/close "gate", jacket on and off posts, over a bridge, square shape of poles on the ground to show a 180 degree turn on the forehand and/or turn on the haunches, trot poles, bending through cones, etc.)

Barrel Racing (class 17)

Timed class through staking cones, in a pattern of 3 barrels and back through the cones

Stake Race (Class 18)

Timed class through starting cones in a figure 8 pattern and back through the cones

Turn and Burn (class 19)

Timed class through starting cones, down and a full circle around a pole and back through the end cones

***** Classes 17, 18 & 19 are open to both Western and English riders.**

Patterns for all classes will be posted at the in gate. These classes are timed events with one horse in the ring at a time. A 5 second penalty is added for any obstacles knocked over
